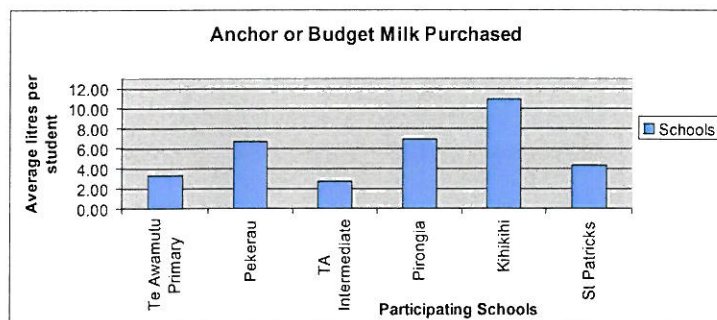

MID YEAR INTERVIEWS – Monday 4th / Tuesday 5th July 2011

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Mid Year interviews are to be held in Week 10. The purpose of this interview is:

- for you, your child and the classroom teacher to discuss progress with the learning goals set at the Goal Setting Interviews in March
- To give an interim report on where your child is working as measured against the National Standards in Reading, Writing and Mathematics as the school interprets these.

ALL Students are encouraged to attend and participate in these interviews with parents

For students in Years 4 – 8, this report will come home on Friday 1st July. Please bring this report with you to the interview. For students in their first 3 years at school, you may have already received an interim or end of year National Standards Report at the end of term following their 1st, 2nd, or 3rd anniversary at school. If this coincides with the end of Term 2, your child will receive an end of year Standards Report also on the above date. In any case, feel free to make an appointment to discuss your child's learning goals.

THE ONLINE BOOKING SYSTEM: Our interview booking form is available **ONLINE**. Please log on to: www.Schoolinterviews.co.nz. Under the heading 'Parents', enter the school code: **RRK2F** and click on "Go". Then complete the 3 steps to book your interview. As we have some composite classes, e.g. two classes with year 7 children, you will see that Mr Norman is listed under one Yr 7 and Mrs Russ is listed under the other Yr 7, **so make sure you book with the correct teacher.**

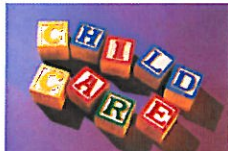
