Dear parents/caregivers,

Now that the process of the actual uniform is completed, we now want to turn our attention to how the uniform is / should be worn and to the various accessories that may accompany the wearing of the uniform.

Our current procedure (U1) is outlined below, together with a place for you to agree (tick), disagree (tick), and if you disagree, to write a suggestion / comment.

U1 Uniform

The uniform is a tradition of St Patrick's Catholic School and perhaps the most visual statement of our school's identity in the wider community of who we are and what our school stands for. The way the uniform is worn also conveys a strong message about our school. Parents, students and staff have a shared responsibility in maintaining uniform standards i.e. keeping the uniform clean, presentable and worn with pride.

In order to maintain a uniform standard, students are expected to present themselves in a clean, neat and tidy manner. This means students:


CURRENT PROCEDURE	AGREE	DISAGREE	COMMENT
1. Wear authorised uniform to and from school, and to related activities i.e. Mass, assembly, class trips, sporting exchanges, cultural activities			
2. Remove shoes, wet weather gear and tracksuits when entering classrooms.			
3. Wear shoes with their socks when moving around the school.			
4. Ensure shorts are worn on or above the hips.			
5. Have the pinafore or skirt of length that it is no shorter than 10cm off the ground when kneeling			
6. Bring suitable sports clothing during the winter terms			
7. The school also requires students to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. wear sunhats during the 1st and 4th terms. Only the regulation sunhats to be worn with school uniform b. wear only one plain silver or gold stud per ear lobe

c. may wear any religious or cultural items/emoles under their shirts., Teachers may students to remove these during PE/ sports activities.			
d. may wear a plain watch.			
e. not wear nail polish, make-up or hair colouring			
f. keep their hair tidy and long hair clipped or tied back with hair clips / ties / scrunchies etc which must be of the colours: navy, maroon or black.			
g. Ensure all items of uniform are clearly named.			
h. Non uniform Shorts or coloured T shirts are not to be worn under the uniform			
i. Bring PE gear to school each day			
The Board of Trustees has asked staff and the Principal to enforce these guidelines. This means that students without the correct uniform, or with dyed or coloured hair, are to be excluded from representing the school at educational, sporting and cultural events. Parents are asked to communicate with the school in writing if their children are unable to meet these requirements.
