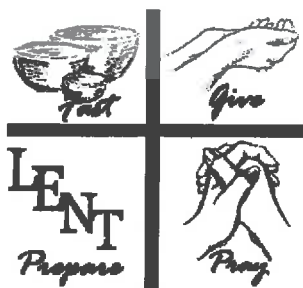

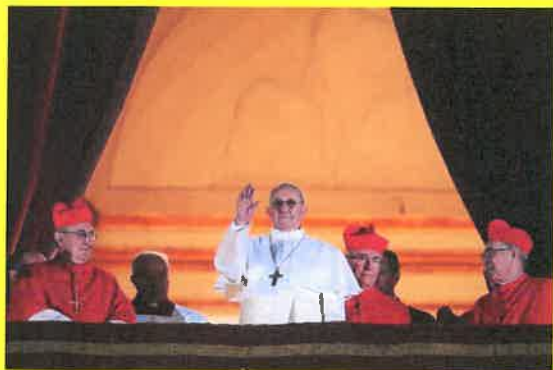

Cardinals have elected Argentine Cardinal Jorge Bergoglio as the new pope to lead the world's 1.2 billion Catholics, to select the 266th pontiff in a remarkably fast conclave.

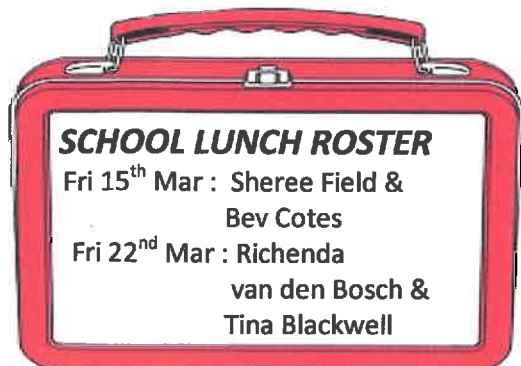
### **Relay for Life**

## FIZZY DRINKS

Fizzy drinks contain lots of sugar which is not good for children's teeth. Fizzy drinks also contain no goodness (vitamins, minerals etc) for growing children.

1 can fizzy drink  
= 10 tsp sugar  
1 600ml bottle fizzy drink  
= 16 tsp sugar



## ENERGY DRINKS

Energy drinks not only contain a large amount of sugar but they also contain caffeine which can dangerously raise your heart rate. Energy drinks are not recommended for children because of this.

1 x 250ml can (V)  
= 7 tsp sugar  
1 x 500ml can (Mother)  
= 13 tsp sugar



## FRUIT DRINK VS FRUIT JUICE

**FRUIT JUICE** contains real fruit which gives you vitamins and minerals. One glass of fruit juice still contains 6 teaspoons of natural sugar (from the fruit) so have no more than 1 glass a day.

**FRUIT DRINKS** such as E2 and Ribena are made up of sugar, water and flavourings with no real fruit.

1 x 250ml carton Ribena  
= 6 tsp sugar  
1 x 750ml bottle E2  
= 20 tsp sugar

Look for the words "fruit juice" on the label to ensure a healthy choice
