

Mrs Jackman is on the road to recovery after (planned) back surgery. Our prayers are with you!




### The pressure is on !!!!!

2. Cook spoonfuls in a hot pan till golden, flip and cook on the other side; serve with a green salad



## STUFFED SPUDS

1. Scrub 5 medium potatoes, prick and microwave till soft; halve potatoes,
2. scoop out and mash flesh
3. Cook 1 diced onion and 200g of bacon
4. Add 1 tin of creamed corn, 1½C of diced vegetables and mashed potato
5. Mix and spoon into potato shells and sprinkle with cheese and bake at 180°C for 10 minutes; serve with salad

### Hearing & Vision Checks at School

Technicians will be at our school on **26<sup>th</sup> November at 11am** and will carry out Hearing & Vision Checks on children who :

- require catch up screening, who have not completed the 'B4 school' checks.
- were absent when the tests were last carried out.
- require re-testing or follow- testing.
- In special circumstances, where teachers or parents have made specific requests.
- are new immigrants.

#### What tests are carried out?

**Ears :** Audiometry – hearing test.

Tympanometry – middle ear function test (only carried out when hearing test results are not within the normal range.)

**Eyes :** Long distance vision test – not a complete visual examination, but a simple screening test.

Colour vision test – Y7 boys only.

All test are non-invasive, safe and should cause no discomfort.

Parents are notified of all results.

Parents have the option of withdrawing their child from this testing, please contact the school in writing before the technician arrive.
