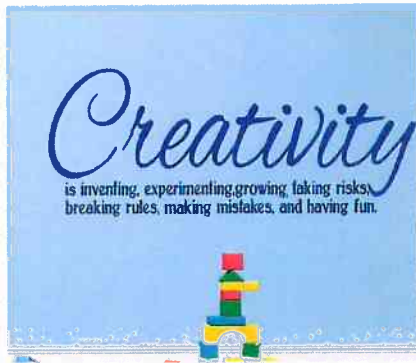

## Information Technology at St Patrick's

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

Further to the information in the newsletters last year and this year we thought we would give you an update in regards to Information Technology at St Pat's.

### 1. Update of our infrastructure

Currently we are in the final stages of our ultra high speed internet connection that is being provided free by the government as part of the their broadband initiative for schools. We are awaiting final connection to our security filtering system provided by Network for Learning ( N4L). Once this has been established we will also need all devices to have 'Google Console' installed ( see BYOD below) and as a further security measure we will be installing Hapara ( there will be a small yearly cost per student for this).

### 2. Google Apps for Education

We are a Google Apps for Education (GAFE) school. This enables us to enhance the way we use technology and share information within and beyond our school community. As staff members are becoming more confident in our use of GAFE, and can see the educational benefits of having our classes also using GAFE. This has proven to be a successful venture with students collaborating with each other and with their teachers. We are now steadily working towards being ready to launch GAFE to all students from Team 2 and 3 as this year progresses.

#### What does this mean for my student?

- Students will be given a google email (eg *[first.lastname]@stpatta.co.nz*) with their own password. This becomes their username and password for all web-based tools that we currently use.
- At this stage students are only able to email, communicate and share work with St Patrick's staff and students.
- All student correspondence will be checked randomly by the class teacher and made to ensure that correspondence is school work related only.
- Alongside our Cybersafety Agreement, a list of GAFE Focus Reminders (*see below*) will be glued into homework books, to remind students of our Digital Citizenship expectations when using GAFE.
- GAFE will act as a platform for teaching students the necessary skills to be responsible digital citizens.

#### As a parent, what do I need to know and do?

- Whilst in school, all internet traffic is filtered by Network For Learning's (N4L) firewall. This does not transfer to the home environment and as a result we cannot control inappropriate content students may encounter and save in their Google Docs. Whilst in school, we prepare students for these encounters and expect them to report any untoward occurrences to the teacher. We encourage you to spend some time discussing consequences of inappropriate use with your children, monitor their time on devices and perhaps consider using a parental control.
- Parents may also want to use this opportunity to explore GAFE with your child and decide on your own home rules to keep cyber safe.
- Students should consider their school email as an extension of the classroom, subject to the same rules of respect and courtesy that we expect in school. As you talk to your child about the acceptable use of email, you might use an analogy of adults' work and personal emails. Most employers ask that work email only be used for work, and employers have access to view and limit use of email to make

sure it is used appropriately.

- When students leave St Patrick's their Google account will be deleted. However this will not happen immediately as to give time for students to transfer their record of learning to another school based account.

#### **GAFE Focus Reminders:**

- Do not share passwords.
- GAFE is for school work only.
- Teachers can monitor all items created and shared.
- Be courteous on all documents.

Essentially, GAFE is a cloud based learning platform allowing teachers and students to create a range of documents online, email, share calendars and 30 gigabytes of data to be accessed at home and school on any device. GAFE allows us to collaborate and learn more effectively through the use of technology, and offer a range of new learning opportunities for teachers and students.

Learning does not just happen within the confines of classrooms between 9am and 3pm. Our teachers, like our students, are on a life-long learning journey and with today's technology it can happen anytime, anywhere. Keeping in line with our Cyber Safety Agreement, we will be working with students to educate them around using GAFE in a productive and responsible manner.

### **3. BYOD**

As the infrastructure is completed and GAFE is up and running we will then be in a position for students to bring their own devices. Our plan is to start this at the senior end of the school and we will let you know A) when the infrastructure is ready and B) when your child's class is ready to start this journey.


In the meantime feel free to buy a Chromebook or iPad by having a look at the Cyclone Portal ([www.cyclone.co.nz](http://www.cyclone.co.nz) password: *stpatta*). They offer a competitive package for our school that includes Google Console for Chromebooks, which is a critical part of device management needed for our school. If you decide to buy elsewhere, you may find the device may not include Google Console. This device will need to be handed into the school for it to be set-up for our network which will include installing Google Console. There is a cost of \$46 inclusive of GST to parents for the cost of the license.
